


- Ensure compliance with the environmental legislation and regulations applicable in each countries where we operate.






Electricity consumption

WASTE MANAGEMENT


Proper waste management has always been a central part of the commitment and environmental awareness at Royalton White Sands Resort & Spa.

Ensuring a proper segregation from root and a final disposal applicable to each type of waste.


Reduction practices include:

Straw Consumption Comparative




Waste Recovery Comparative
