Legal Requirements

If hosting a legal ceremony, we require the bride and groom, including two witnesses to arrive 3 business days prior to the wedding date (Day of arrival does count). For Symbolic ceremonies, we require the bride and groom to arrive 2 days in advance (Day of arrival does count).

DOCUMENTATION FOR LEGAL CEREMONY:

Clear copies of the below documents must be sent via email to your wedding consultant in advance and originals brought with you to destination.

- Valid Passports
- Original Birth Certificates
- Sworn Affidavit (or letter from a Lawyer or Registry), attesting that neither party has been married previously
- Decree Absolute, for each divorced party
- If widowed, Death Certificate of the deceased
- Legal proof if a name was changed by Deed Poll
- If under 21 years, written parental consent by way of an Affidavit from a Lawyer or Notary Public

DOCUMENTATION FOR SYMBOLIC CEREMONY:

For a Vow Renewal or Symbolic Ceremony, couples do need to be married in advance. A clear copy of your marriage certificate must be sent via email to your wedding consultant in advance and brought with you to destination.

If documents are not in English, they must be translated and notarised.

The couple must arrive three (3) business days prior to the wedding date. A one (1) day residency option is available at an increased cost.

The cost of legal wedding is a \$550.00 USD which includes the marriage license and Minister.

Witnesses are required for a legal wedding. Two (2) people must witness and sign the marriage certificate. If necessary, the resort will provide these.

The wedding couple will be given a marriage certificate on the day of the wedding. A certified copy will be required for legal transactions in your home country which the Wedding Coordinator will obtain from the marriage registry. There is a cost of US\$10.00 per copy, which will need to be paid at the resort.
